Appeal Fund Launch Activity:

Sunday, 27 July 2025 @ 2:30 PM at Redemption Centre, 193 Plumstead Road, Norwich, NR1 4AB we will launch the Church Rebuilding Appeal Fund with the following scheme.

We will PRAYER WALK all the Streets of Norwich for God, to raise funds for the re-building of the church. PRAYER WALK your neighbourhood for just one hour once a week for one year to raise funds for our church rebuilding project (personally, it's going to be daily except I am not in Norwich).

The scheme will conclude at this same location on Sunday, 26 July 2026 at 2:30 PM. We should have raised the 1 million pounds. Gift aided we shall apply gift aid to boost the amount raised to 1.2 million pounds.

Maybe, you say I cannot PRAYER WALK that. You have the option to PRAY DRIVING THROUGH every street in Norwich whilst praying the same prayers as those prayer walking.

To PRAYER WALK your neighbour and other streets in Norwich, set up a Bank Standing Order of £20 (twenty pounds) per Week for 50 Weeks. If you are doing Drive Through Prayer, set up a Bank Standing Order of £100 (one hundred pounds) per Month for 10 Months.

Prayer Points:

- 1. Let there be peace on our streets, every street in Norwich
- 2. Let there be prosperity in our palaces, our homes, schools, businesses, institutions. Prosperity for the City of Norwich.
- 3. Father, turn the hearts of men & women, boys & girls, infants & toddlers to yourself O' Lord. Let there be salvation, deliverance and freedom in our streets.
- 4. Lift up your heads o ye gates; and let the king of glory shall come in. Every gate, physical & spiritual in Norwich & Norfolk be lifted & let Christ be enthroned. Breaking strongholds and ungodly influences in the life of the people.
- 5. Father, in your own miraculous ways, raise funds for the rebuilding of your church as we prayer walk the streets of Norwich IJMN.
